HISTORY

The Indian Colleges Forum was set up as response to bring colleges of India on a single platform to deliberate on the issues of development collegiate education in the country so that a large number of students studying in colleges can benefit from these developments and contribute to development of society at large. The ICF was started in the year 1992 and its first conference was held in Delhi. As on 2011 about 500 colleges from all over the country are members of ICF. It has held 17 Annual Conferences of Principals of Colleges in different parts of the country.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of Indian Colleges Forum are to :

- i) provide a common platform to the Heads of colleges at an all India level to discuss issues of development of collegiate education in India;
- ii) make policy recommendations regarding development of colleges based on considered opinions of the heads of the colleges and on the basis of scientific studies;
- iii) provide a common place for exchanging ideas, sharing of experiences and views, and for training of key personnel for the development of colleges in India.
- iv) work for promoting the academic interest of colleges, principals, teachers, students and other groups connected with collegiate education in India;
- v) help colleges to prepare plan proposals for overall or any specific aspect(s) of the development of colleges;
- vi) provide information and work as consortium of colleges in India.

ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP

- i) Any College affiliated/ constituent/ autonomous/ associated/ recognised by University/ AICTE can become member of the ICF.
- ii) Membership is permanent and is of institution.
- iii) Chairman / Principal of College Represent the member College.

Membership Fee : One time Registration - Rs 5000/-
 Annual Subscription - Rs 1000/-

ICF COMMITTEE

ICF committees will be constituted on the basis of senior-most member as State Secretary within a State and senior-most member College within a Region as Regional Chairperson on rotation basis. Seniority of membership of ICF would be determined on the basis of date of joining the ICF.
