HISTORY

The Indian Colleges Forum was set up as response to bring colleges of India on a single platform to deliberate on the issues of development collegiate education in the country so that a large number of students studying in colleges can benefit from these developments and contribute to development of society at large. The ICF was started in the year 1992 and its first conference was held in Delhi. As on 2011 about 500 colleges from all over the country are members of ICF. It has held 17 Annual Conferences of Principals of Colleges in different parts of the country.
